What is an Urgent Treatment Centre?

The Northside Urgent Treatment Centre provides access to care for those with unexpected, but non-life-threatening health concerns with appointments offered within one to two days. **Patients will be seen by appointment only.**



Some examples of urgent, non-life-threatening illnesses or injuries include:

- ✓ mild abdominal pain
- ✓ simple fractures
- ✓ limb sprains
- ✓ mild muscle strains/sprains
- ✓ mild headaches
- ✓ earaches
- ✓ minor infections
- ✓ skin and eye irritations
- ✓ mild asthma
- ✓ small lacerations
- ✓ mild mental health support
- ✓ minor respiratory issues

The **Northside Urgent Treatment Centre** is different than an emergency department in that it provides care for non-life-threatening illness or injuries, does not receive ambulances, and only sees patients by appointment.
