#### Who we are

# **Parking**

Parking locations are also shown on the map at the end of this pamphlet. Special parking rates are available for families of long-term inpatients after the patient's 14th consecutive (back to back) day in hospital. Discounted rates are also offered for outpatients with long-term treatment schedules. Please ask staff at the nursing station or clinic registration desk for details.

# Shuttle service

Patients who need transportation between the HI and VG sites can take the patient and staff shuttle, which runs between sites every 20 minutes during the day.


