• Health card number

Records: This is used to describe all health records, including information about your medications, hospital visits and stays, health visits and immunizations. It also refers to the information about the appointments you had for diagnostic imaging tests.

Results: This refers to the information from your diagnostic imaging, blood, urine, and general lab tests. Lab and diagnostic imaging results may include what we would think of as the result of the test, such as "Immune" or "Positive", or they may only contain general information such as the ordering provider, lab location, and result date and time.

Reports: These are more detailed records that include the clinician's interpretation of the diagnostic imaging test. Currently, we only offer reports for X-rays and ultrasounds.
